Schools should complete Formative Assessment - III between the months of **October - November** in the form of dictation, reading, Class Assignment, Home Assignment, projects, activities, quizzes, group discussion etc. as per the requirement of subject with proper documentation. (To be reduced to 10% weightage).

**Formative - 4**

Usual Paper-Pencil Test to be conducted between **July - August** and reduced to 10% weightage.
